These are some of the measures we have implemented at Unisson:

- ✓ Adherence to the latest guidelines for COVID-19 from NSW Health
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccinations for all staff
- ✓ COVID safe practices such as the use of PPE and hand sanitising
- ✓ Twice weekly RAT tests for all staff, to stay on top of infections
- ✓ Regular cleaning of our vehicles
- ✓ Regular cleaning of surfaces at our premises
- ✓ Smaller groups at our centres
- ✓ Limited contact between different groups at our community access centres
- ✓ More group outings away from our centres, with smaller numbers of clients
- ✓ Clients spending less than 4 hours together at a time
- ✓ Clients spending more time outdoors at our centres, weather permitting
